- 3. What were your impressions of Nicodemus and his helplessness before the demonpossessed Mary Magdalene?
- 4. In what ways can you identify with Mary Magdalene? We are being shown each character's "before Jesus" life. What does an encounter with Jesus do to people?
- 5. How is your encounter with Jesus changing YOU? What parts of your "before" has God redeemed, and which are you most grateful for?
- 6. Jesus speaks: "I have called you by name, you are mine" to THE CHOSEN in this episode, but He also speaks it to us today. Discuss the impact of what this means in your life. What have you been delivered from and what have you been delivered FOR?
