The LifeStudents Director plays a vital role and is responsible for developing, implementing, and promoting student ministry with an emphasis on 6th-grade -12th-grade students and parents. This role is tasked with developing and maintaining a vibrant LifeStudents ministry while training and equipping a team of volunteers. This role requires leadership skills and a desire to invest heavily in and serve the local community. The LifeStudents Director is responsible for the scope and sequence of bible teaching and LifeGroup discipleship. Additionally, coordinates routine community-building activities, events, mission trips, camps, and retreats that are creative and interactive, and according to the ministry focus. As a ministry leader, this position will work with and support other staff to execute the ministry model that the church is founded upon (A.C.T.S.)

- Plan and execute LifeStudents programs both during worship services and throughout the week
- Lead initiatives to connect with and reach local families, organizations, groups, and local schools
- Coordinate with Campus Pastor to ensure consistency and excellence of programming across grade-levels
- Develop consistent communication and workflow through the church database
- Support campus staff in the execution of the LifeFamily ministry vision for all age-ranges
- Engage the hearts and lives of the students and their families we have the honor of serving
- Equip and disciple students to become passionate and mature followers of Jesus
- Recruit, equip, and invest in the student Dream Team to provide an infrastructure for long-term stability and growth
- Evaluate and continually develop LifeStudents programming
- Attend all meetings as requested
- Collaborate with NextGen teams, organize and administer all camps/retreats for Students ministry
- Plan and implement Middle and High School activities/events
- Leader/volunteer coordination for major events
- Study, teach, and equip leaders and students in God's word
- Create discipleship opportunities through one-on-ones and the LifeGroup model within the Student Ministry
- Coordinate with LifeKids staff on transitioning students into the middle school ministry
- Coordinate with the NextGen Pastor for Young Adults/Singles on transitioning High School students into LifeYoungAdults
